3. Improving Midian membership improves our financial position!


There are likely many more ways to improve our membership and many more benefits as well. We need all of Nobility's help in our mission!

Monthly Dues Payment Plans

Midian is excited to offer its members the ability to pay dues on-line or select a monthly payment plan for their dues. This is through PayPal and is very secure. You do not need a PayPal account but it's recommended. Please note that the total amount you pay is \$10 a year more than your dues. This is to help pay for the cost of this platform and you can cancel anytime. If you have a PayPal account, enter your email, if you don't click pay with credit card.

There are 5 options to enroll based on your situation. Just go to midianshrine. org and click the "Pay Dues" button to sign up!

OPTION 1: Stay current on Midian dues. Enroll and current dues are paid. Enrollment time is January through June.

• You will pay \$30 a month for the next 6 months which will pay your next year's dues. After the 1st 6 months of \$30 you will be charged \$15 a month which is applied to your future year's dues.

OPTION 2: Stay current on Midian dues. Enroll and next year's dues are paid. Enrollment time is June through December.

• You will pay \$15 a month for the next 12 months which will pay your following year's dues. After the 1st 12 months you will continue to be charged \$15 a month which is applied to future dues.

OPTION 3: Stay current on Midian dues. Enroll and pay next year's dues. Enrollment time is June through December.

• You will pay \$180 now plus \$15 a month for the next 12 months which will pay your following year's dues. After the 1st 12 months you will continue to be charged \$15 a month which is applied to your future year's dues.

Option 4: Pay Annual Midian Dues. No Enrollment time. This is a one-time payment and not a subscription.

• You will pay \$180 for one month which will pay your annual dues.

Perpetual Life Membership Payments. Enroll anytime.

• You will pay \$375 now which will pay your dues for the next two years. Then you will pay \$163.09 a month for the next 23 months. This will pay your dues for Perpetual Life.





The New Year is here and we are C off and running. The January meeting had to be rescheduled due to the ice and snow storm we had. We finally had our meeting January 13th.


Antique Auto's dues are \$50, and \$25 for Veterans. They are due the end of January and considered late beginning February 1st.



was born in Salzburg in what is now Austria on January 27, 1756. His father, Leopold was a minor composer and a violinist who taught older sister, Maria Anna, and Wolfgang. As is fairly common knowledge in Wolfgang's

short 35-year life, he composed many works: symphonies, concertos, smaller ensembles, operas. Wolfgang married Constanze Weber in 1782. They had six children of whom only two survived infancy.

On 14 December 1784, Mozart became a Freemason, admitted to the lodge Zur Wohltatigkeit. He went to meetings and a number of his friends were Masons. Mozart died December 5, 1791.

The 1984 movie "Amadeus" although not entirely accurate historically is an engrossing take on the life of Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart.


